Media Advisory San Antonio Regional Service Center Relocation

(AUSTIN, Texas – September 24, 2024) The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) San Antonio Regional Service Center will open in a new location at 6909 North Loop 1604 E, Suite 1199, in the Rolling Oaks Mall, on Wednesday, October 9. The current location at 15150 Nacogdoches Road will close permanently at the end of the business day on Friday, October 4. It is important for customers to be aware of this change.

Customer service improvements at the new office include a larger and more comfortable space with room to grow, ample parking for passenger vehicles and trucks, and the convenience for customers who may choose to wait, browse or eat in the mall before or after their appointment.

Please note that most in-person vehicle title and registration services, including vehicle registration renewals and title applications, are provided at the county tax assessor-collectors' offices in each county, and driver licenses are issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety.
