

Attention Motor Vehicle Dealers: A New State Law Takes Effect July 1, 2025

- Eliminates six (6) paper tags and permits
- Creates four (4) new metal license plates to replace eliminated paper tags and permits
- Changes how license plates are handled after a sale or transfer

- Requires dealers to use webDEALER to submit transactions
- Requires dealers to submit a Vehicle
 Transfer Notification (VTN) at the
 time of sale or trade-in to a dealer
- Allocates metal license plate inventory based on sales

Attention Motor Vehicle Dealers: A New State Law Takes Effect July 1, 2025



As of July 1, 2025, dealers must submit **all transactions** using webDEALER



Dealers without webDEALER accounts will not be able to complete sales transactions beginning July 1, 2025



Dealers are required to complete mandatory webDEALER training

Attention Motor Vehicle Dealers: A New State Law Takes Effect July 1, 2025



As of July 1, 2025, dealers must submit all title and registration transactions using webDEALER



Dealers without webDEALER accounts will not be able to complete sales transactions beginning July 1, 2025

Changes to Texas License Plates Begin July 1, 2025

NEW Temporary Registration Plate



- Issued by county tax offices or TxDMV Regional Service Centers
- Replaces paper one-trip and 30-day permits; safety inspection not required
- Can be used for export sales



Changes to Texas License Plates Begin July 1, 2025

NEW Buyer Provisional Plate



- Issued by a dealer if the applicable license plate type is not available in their inventory
- Expires 7 days after permanent plates are assigned



Changes to Texas License Plates Begin July 1, 2025

NEW Out-of-State Buyer Plate



- Issued by a dealer for a vehicle sold to an out-of-state buyer
- Valid for 60 days
- Plates do not need to be returned after expiration



Changes to Texas License Plates Begin July 1, 2025

NEW Dealer Temporary Limited Use Plate



Dealers: Submit your plate application now through your eLICENSING account

- Used by dealers for test drives, loaner vehicles, or transporting vehicles
- <u>Cannot</u> be used by dealers for <u>personal use of</u> vehicles
- Does not replace existing standard dealer plates
- \$10 each upon issuance



Changes to Texas License Plates Begin July 1, 2025





- Dealers issue permanent metal plates at point of sale
- Most temporary paper permits are eliminated



Selling or Trading In A Vehicle?

Changes to Texas License Plates Begin July 1, 2025

Dealers are required to remove general-issue license plates upon trade-in or sale to the dealer



- General-issue plates may be transferred to another vehicle of the same type sold by the dealer within 10 days, or must be destroyed
- Sellers in a private-party sale may retain their plates and transfer them to another vehicle of the same type they own, with approval



Selling A Vehicle?

Changes to Texas License Plates Begin July 1, 2025

When a vehicle is sold, specialty and qualifying plates always remain with the seller





Sellers in a private-party sale may retain their general-issue plates and transfer them to another vehicle of the same type they own, with approval

Selling A Vehicle?

Vehicle Transfer Notifications (VTNs)



For private sales, **submit within 30 days** of the vehicle's date of transfer to its new owner using **form VTR-346** or **online**: **TxDMV.gov/VTN**



Protect yourself from liability for criminal or civil acts involving the new owner, such as toll violations



Beginning July 1, 2025, motor vehicle dealers are required to submit a VTN for you within 30 days if you sell or trade in a vehicle
