## Document Overview

---

This document describes the latest software changes made to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) webDEALER software application.

### Scope

The scope of this is to identify recent software changes to the webDEALER application as documented in the latest webDEALER User Guides. This document does not provide step-by-step instructions on how to use webDEALER.

### Audience

The intended audience of this document are users of webDEALER.

## Enhancements in Release 25.2

---

### **Emission Inspection Requirements are Based Off Dealer and Buyer County**

As part of the webDEALER title application process, an emissions inspection will be required for a non-commercial vehicle, provided both the dealer location and buyer address are in an emissions county and all other emission inspection requirements are met.

### **The Emissions Inspection Fee is Charged If Found in The Inspection Database**

As part of the webDEALER title application process, the Emissions Inspection Fee will be charged as part of a webDEALER title application for a noncommercial vehicle if an emissions inspection is found for the vehicle in the inspection database.

### **Noncommercial Vehicles are Treated as Commercial Vehicles if a Commercial Vehicle Inspection is Found or Manually Entered**

As part of the webDEALER title application process, if a commercial vehicle inspection exists for the vehicle in the inspection database or the commercial vehicle inspection type is manually entered by a dealer, the vehicle is not subject to Emissions Inspection Fee or the Inspection Replacement Fee. Instead, the corresponding commercial vehicle inspection fee will be charged.

### **Buyer Tags for Out of State Vehicles are Excluded from the Emissions Inspection Fee and Inspection Replacement Fee**

As part of the eTAG buyer tag process, retail sales of vehicles that will be titled and registered outside of the state of Texas are not subject to the Emissions Inspection Fee or the Inspection Replacement Fee. However, if an inspection is found in the inspection database or the specific inspection type is manually identified by a dealer for said vehicle, the corresponding inspection fee will be charged.
