

Self-Certification of Travel Trailers More Than 7,500 lbs.

Instructions

This form may be used by owners of travel trailers with a gross vehicle weight more than **7,500 lbs.** to certify the vehicle described is in proper and safe condition. Self-certification is allowed under state law for the purpose of registration.

If renewing by mail, submit the completed application with your renewal notice along with payment of fees due as shown on the renewal notice in the form of a personal check, money order, or cashier's check; payable to your local county collector's office. **Do not mail cash**.

Note: Under state law, trailers including travel trailers with a gross vehicle weight (GVW) of 7,500 lbs. or less are <u>not required</u> to obtain a state safety inspection. This form is not required for any trailer or travel trailer with a GVW of 7,500 lbs. or less.

Dealers may submit this form on behalf of a retail purchaser of a travel trailer with a GVW more than 7,500 lbs. The completed form must be submitted to the county of registration with the title application.
